SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Town of Orland Solid Waste Transfer Station is located at 180 Gray Meadow Road, in Orland

This facility is for disposal of Orland residential trash only.

- No Commercial Haulers allowed
- No Contractor vehicles allowed

TRANSFER STATION DECALS

A decal on the vehicle is required for access to the facility. Decals will be available at the Transfer Station.

A current vehicle registration or real estate tax bill must be presented in order to obtain a decal.

Specific colored stickers will be issued to Orland residents and a different color will be issued to seasonal residents.

<u>WEATHER RELATED CLOSURES</u>	
During severe weather the attendant may close the Transfer Station on a temporary basis to direct available personnel resources toward weather-related needs. All such temporary closures will be posted to the Town's website and Facebook page with as much prior notice as possible.	

BEFORE YOU GO TO THE TRANSFER STATION DISPOSAL TIPS.....

- Tires all must have rims removed. No more than ten tires will be accepted.
- Tires must be able to fit into the compactor.
- Paint cans must be dry.
- Metal barrels must have at least one end removed and they must be washed out.
- Leaves, grass, and yard/garden clippings must be bagged and disposed of in the trash compactors along with solid waste.
- Tree limbs and branches must not exceed 10' in length.

OTHER DISPOSAL POLICIES AND FEES:

- Clean Wood – Includes brush, trees no larger than 6" diameter, or lumber with no nails and free of lead paint and cresol and no longer than 10' in length.
Limit to two loads per household Fee: \$15.00/half-ton load
- Metal Items – Metal items are accepted at no fee
- Propane containers – Fee: \$10.00/small \$20/100#
- Refrigerators (with doors removed) Fee: \$15.00
- Air Conditioners – Fee: \$15.00
- Dehumidifiers – Fee: \$15.00
- Asphalt Shingles (includes tar paper) – must be free of wood and paper.
Limit to two loads per household Fee: \$35.00/half-ton load
- Swap Shop items will be accepted in limited quantities, up to the discretion of the attendant.
- Televisions, computer parts and fluorescent lamps will be accepted at no fee

The Town of Orland operates a Zero-Sort recycling program at the Transfer Station. There is a separate container at the facility in which many recyclables are deposited. There is no need to separate these recyclable materials.

PLEASE DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLING

RECYCLING NEEDS TO BE LOOSE!

ACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLES

PAPER

- Cardboard/*all* boxes
- Newspaper & inserts, junk mail
- Books
- Magazines, catalogs, phone books
- Paper bags
- Office paper, window envelopes
- Paper plates (clean), pizza boxes
- Wrapping paper
- Milk, juice cartons, drink boxes, aseptic containers
- Gift boxes, cereal boxes
- Shredded paper (put in clear bag)

PLASTIC

- All empty rigid containers marked #1-#7, *except Styrofoam*
- Water bottles
- Detergent bottles
- Milk juice

METAL

- Tin cans
- Aerosol cans (empty)
- Aluminum cans/foil
- Pots & pans

GLASS

Empty bottles & jars (clean, all colors)

***All containers must be empty. They do not have to be completely clean, but empty and without substantial food residual.

UNACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLES

- NO PLASTIC BAGS!
- NO FOOD WASTE!
- NO BAGGED RECYCLING! (The only exception to this rule is shredded paper in a clear plastic bag).
- NO ITEMS LARGER THAN A 5 GALLON BUCKET
- Trash Bags, Pellet bags, bread bags, animal food bags, frozen vegetable bags, newspaper bags, snack bags, chip bags, sandwich bags, NO BAGS (except paper)
- Food waste and liquid in containers
- Plants, dirt, any putricibles
- Plastic wrap or film
- Wood/Lumber
- Large metal parts
- Pipes (plastic or metal)
- Hoses, garden hoses
- Rope, string, chains
- Clothing, shoes, bedding, pillows
- Light bulbs (any type; return CFLs to store)
- Batteries
- Needles, sharps, knives and blades
- Napkins, paper towels
- Bubble wrap, styrofoam, tyvek envelopes
- Wax-coated paper or boxes (poly coated ok)
- Tyvek, Vinyl siding
- Window glass
- Toys
- Diapers, kitty litter
- Propane, helium or other gas cylinders

KEEP IT LOOSE! DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLING. BAGGED RECYCLING WILL NOT BE RECYCLED!

Single stream is leading-edge technology that eliminates the need to separate recyclables by category for collection. The benefits of single stream are increased participation in recycling which means less waste in our waste streams. National statistics show that single-sort recycling systems result in more recycling. Why? Because it's so much easier for residents, there is no sorting and requires less time.

Instead of separating recyclables by type, simply combine all glass, metal, paper, cardboard, and plastics #1-7 into one recycling container.
